



CuRows™ Solo Rules For Culica®

Variation - Classic

Mode: single player / puzzle

Difficulty: Bit tricky at first.

Rules

Put 14 pegs of each colour in the bag. Pull 9 pegs out at random. Arrange the pegs on one face of the Culica. (The top picture *has an example*).

Then pull another nine pegs and fill another face on the Culica. Repeat until the Culica is filled.

Note, pegs on completed faces cannot be moved.

The idea is to create a long row of pegs of the same colour. The row can go round the Culica, but must comprise side-by-side pegs (not diagonal).



Scoring:

- ✓ Count the pegs in your longest row of pegs of the same colour, that's your score. Note your highest score and see if you can beat it next time.
- ✓ A row that stretches all round the Culica (12 points) gets four bonus points – a rare event!

In the picture, right, shows an example game in progress after two faces have been filled. So far a row of five blue pegs has been made. That is the longest row, longer than the row of four red pegs.



Tip

If two players have a Culica each then compete at CuRows! Player One draws pegs at random, as usual. Player Two draws pegs from his own bag of the same colours as player one. Each player puts their pegs on any face of their own Culica as desired (hide your Culica to prevent copying!) At the end, the longest row wins!
