



CuWizard™ Solo Rules For Culica®

Variation - Classic

Mode: single player / puzzle

Difficulty: Bit tricky at first.

Rules

Put pegs on the Culica cube to make CuWizards (see below).

A *CuWizard* is a straight row of four pegs, each of a different colour, and with two pegs on one face and two on another (*see figure, above right*).



To win:

- ✓ Make as many CuWizards as you can. One point for each CuWizard made!
- ✓ Perfect score: Put all of the pegs into the Culica cube, so that every straight row of four pegs with two pegs on one face and two on another is a CuWizard!



Notes

Note that CuWizards may criss-cross in vertical and horizontal directions (not diagonal). So each peg may belong to more than one CuWizard (*see figure, right, for an example*).

CuWizard is a Culica analogy of SuDoku: there are colours instead of numbers, and CuWizard rows instead of SuDoku squares.

If you can make the Perfect Score, then you are in the *CuWizard Club*.
